Extra-Curricular Eligibility

Students wishing to participate in a club/sport must meet the academic requirements set forth by Central Middle School.

Eligibility Procedures:

- Grades begin being pulled one full week after the start of trimester. At least 2 grades in the grade book.
- If a student has an "F" in one or more classes they will be placed on probation for that week.
- The student/athlete will have one week to get their grade up to an eligible level.
- Coaches will inform the athlete and parent of the ineligibility.
- The student may participate in contest/games the remainder of that week.
- If the student's grade for any class remains an "F" by the following Monday (when grades are again pulled) they will be considered ineligible for any games or contest that week.
- Students will still be required to attend practice or homework club when ineligible.
- If an athlete is marked scholastically ineligible for 3 consecutive weeks the student will be removed from sport or club.
- Students may not participate in any practice/games/contests while on Academic/Social Probation.

*Student-athlete should regularly be checking their grades through PowerSchool with parent/guardian.
